Senior Civil Engineer

- Registered Professional Engineer (P.Eng.) with Engineers Nova Scotia or able to obtain registration within six (6) months.
- Working knowledge of civil engineering software such as Civil 3D, PCSWMM, and WaterCAD or other industry programs is considered an asset.
- Strong experience in the design and construction of civil infrastructure including earthworks, site layout, grading/drainage, municipal roads, sidewalks, parking lots, subdivisions, watermains, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and culverts.
- Strong experience in quantity estimates/cost estimating and preparation of specifications and construction documentation.
- Experience in Project Management including budgets, schedules, safety and quality and managing teams, deliverables and clients in civil engineering and multi-disciplined projects.
- Provide mentoring and technical support to junior staff members.
- Conduct business development activities such as responding to proposals, attending conferences, and maintaining working relationships with clients.

- Superior writing skills in the development of proposals and technical reports is required.
